RETURN TO LEARN: guidance following a positive COVID-19 Symptom Screen



This decision tool is NOT intended for cases or close contacts of COVID-19.

A confirmed COVID-19 case or close contact should follow public health isolation or quarantine instructions for return to school/work.

Only **asymptomatic** close contacts qualify for shortened quarantine. **Symptomatic** close contacts should isolate from symptom onset and pursue evaluation, including testing. If test is negative, they should complete a 14 day quarantine from date of last exposure. Anyone who tests positive using any viral diagnostic test type (not antibody tests) should be treated as a case and should isolate. No additional test results can end a symptomatic positive individual's isolation period early.

All students/staff with symptoms of COVID-19 should be tested as soon as possible. Symptomatic individuals within 90 days of a previous positive viral diagnostic test (not antibody test) and those who are fully vaccinated (2 weeks after final dose) should isolate, be investigated for potential infection in consultation with public health and/or a healthcare provider, and may require testing.
