Earlier today during a press conference, Colorado Governor Jared Polis announced the suspension of in-person learning across our state through April 30, 2020. This order aligns with the President's guidelines announced earlier this week.

As you know WSD3 will launch our distance learning tomorrow, Thursday April 2. We will still continue with this plan and are committed to providing educational services to our families through the emergency closure, no matter how long that may last. We know schools and teachers are communicating with families this week to help you on how distance learning can look for your students. At this time, we do not know if we will return after April 30, 2020, or if the suspension of in-person learning will continue.

Please know, we continue to work closely with the Governor and are following the recommendations of state and regional health professionals. As we learn more, we will share updates in real time.
