



King PTO Meeting: 11 January 2016

The meeting started at 6:10PM.

Mrs. Robinson is leading the meeting after introductions.

Treasurer report: Currently, there is \$4447 in the PTO account, with plans to use it towards Candygrams, allotment for grade levels as well as teacher appreciation week.

Holiday Store: Mrs. Robinson reports that the holiday store did better than in last years, but Mrs. Hubbard will have more information.

School Supplies: Mrs. Robinson reports that if we use Staples as a supplies, the PTO could make some money, however, they do not use name brands. With EduKit we could specify brands, but it seems more expensive (\$25 vs \$40 for a box). We would need to provide the school supply list by April. With EduKit, parents can go online and it is convenient.

Candygrams: Valentine's Day is on a Sunday. PTO will be selling Candygrams 8-12th February before and after school. Student Leadership might be able to help before school. SignUp Genius will be set up to invite other parents to help. Mrs. Reynolds suggested to use other candy, and is willing to research feasible options.

Spring Fundraiser: There is no information as Mrs. Hubbard was unable to attend.

Classroom Allotments: PTO will give \$500 to each grade level, as well as the auxiliary departments. The question was raised if more money should be given to grade levels with more classrooms, but consensus was to leave it the same amount per grade level. If teachers need more, they are welcome to talk to PTO. Final amounts will be confirmed with Mrs. Hubbard.

Box Tops: Mrs. Reynolds gives a report for box tops. Mrs. Jolly won the first pizza rewards party. Box tops are to be sent in March, and the second pizza party will be April 15th. 3000 box tops were collected for a \$600 check.

Principal's Notes: Mrs. Bentley confirms dates in the calendar. After-school intramurals changed this year to exercise led by Mr. Cordoba. The change seems to have been well received. 3rd quarter started with an all-school goal setting activity in the classrooms. Students and teachers were able to reflect on their goals. Report cards went home, and 2nd quarter Renaissance will be 15 January (1.05pm-1.55pm – 4th/5th, 1.55pm-2.25pm – K/1st, 2.25pm-3.15pm – 2nd/3rd). There will be an early release 13 January, which includes hat day. There is no school 18 January in observation of Martin Luther King Jr Day. Choir will commence 19 January. 21 January is Math Night/Family Night; more information to follow.
